40 COMPUTERS TO ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

Kragujevac, Niš and Novi Sad were the places where Komercijalna banka compucted the last donor campaign from project ''40 good things'', which it has carried out since the month of May as a part of marking its 40th anniversary.

By this campaign the Bank donated to the elementary schools from the most undeveloped municipalities 40 sets of information technology equipment which comprise computers, multifunctional printers and monitors.

The computers went to schools in Kosjerić, Velika Sugobina, Velike Pčelice, Gornja Sabanta, Žagubica, Petrovac na Mlavi, Braničevo, Kušići, Rekovac, Studenica, Tutin, Deževa, Karajukovića Bunari, Akmačići, Jabuka, Kratovo, Osečina, Mionica, Medveđa, Vučitrn, Lebane, Vranje, Merošina, Žitorađa, Kaplari, Konjuh, Zvečan, Novo Brdo, Krupanj, Zavlaka, Donja Borina, Bešenovo, Vizići, Radinci, Boka, Bela Crkva, Gakovo, Kruščići, Feketić, Koceljevo and Sajan.

On the occasion of presenting the sets of computer equipment, the Bank's representatives expressed their wish that this equipment would facilitate the everyday life of these children and make it more beautiful, and that it would contribute to their better future and open for them a larger window to the world.

At the same time while showing gratitude for the gifts, the school principals expressed the unanimous opinion that this is a very useful gift which will be promptly set in function for the benefit of those to whom it was intended in the first place – the pupils.
